Kevin Pollak has established himself as both a comedic and dramatic actor, having appeared in over thirty films in the past decade. His ability to portray a wide range of characters has made him one of the first stand-up comedians to have a successful dramatic film career. Pollak played an attorney alongside Tom Cruise in *A Few Good Men*, he was the lovable son of Jack Lemmon in the two *Grumpy Old Men* films, and he was the sociopath Todd Hockney in *The Usual Suspects*. Pollack has completed several scripts and also runs a production company, Calm Down Productions.

Prior to his film career, Pollak had been performing stand-up comedy since the age of ten. He became a touring stand-up at the age of twenty, and is returning to stand-up comedy after a seven-year break.

In 2001, Pollak maintained his prestigious movie career with three new hits to add to his ongoing list. In January, *The Wedding Planner* was released in which Pollak appeared with Matthew McConaughey and Jennifer Lopez. In addition, he played a federal marshal hunting down a diabolical Kevin Costner in *3000 Miles To Graceland*, a fast paced action drama.
