Reid Wilson is the national correspondent for *The Hill* newspaper, Washington, DC's most widely-read political publication. He is an expert in spotting political trends as they develop and forecasting election results long before the ballots are counted. Known for staying ahead of the news through his access to top newsmakers, Wilson is a trusted staple of the political scene. Wilson covered politics for *The Washington Post*, and he's the former editor-in-chief of *National Journal's The Hotline*. His work has appeared in outlets like *The New York Times*, *RealClearPolitics*, *Atlantic Monthly*, *New Republic*, and other major news networks, and his expertise is frequently sought-after by MSNBC, CNN, C-SPAN, and various radio shows across the nation. He is also the Amazon best-selling author of the book, *Epidemic: Ebola and the Global Scramble to Prevent the Next Killer Outbreak*.

In addition to the political happenings themselves, Wilson focused on the coverage of elections and politics, each day printing off every newspaper in the country and reading through more than 500 papers. From Politics To The Supreme Court. Before becoming editor-in-chief, Wilson was editor of *Hotline On Call*, *Hotline's* political blog. He also served as a staff writer at *The Hill*, where he covered Congress, politics, campaigns, and elections. He has covered the Supreme Court, the Federal Election Commission, and top political races as they develop across the country. Reid spent the 2008 election cycle authoring a popular political blog at *RealClearPolitics*, where he covered the presidential caucuses in Iowa, the primaries in New Hampshire, and several debates around the nation. Also during the 2008 cycle, Wilson hosted a nationally-broadcast political talk show on XM Satellite Radio, on which he hosted the nation's top newsmakers, reporters, and analysts. In 2006, he covered polls and polling for *The Hotline*.
