Popular & Trusted Author. In addition to overseeing the editorial staff and writing regular features for *RealClearPolitics*, Bevan's work has appeared in numerous publications, and he is featured frequently as a political analyst on Fox News, CNN, CNBC, the BBC. Bevan is also the co-author (with Carl Cannon) of *The RealClearPolitics Political Download: Election 2012: The Battle Begins* and *The RealClearPolitics Download: Election 2012: A Time for Choosing*. These downloads are part of a three-part series which will turn into a published book after the election.

Outside Of RCP. Bevan also hosts a weekly radio show on 89 WLS-AM in Chicago. The show provides in-depth analysis of politics and elections and airs from 8:00 pm to 9:00 pm central on Sunday nights.

Prior to launching the site in 2000 with Princeton University classmate John McIntyre, Bevan worked for nearly a decade in the advertising and communications industries, starting at Leo Burnett and later moving to Crispin Porter + Bogusky.
