Max Foster plays a pivotal role in CNN's international coverage, often anchoring live from the scene of major breaking news and landmark events. He led programming on multiple European terror attacks, the Brexit referendum and marriage of Prince Harry to Meghan Markle at Windsor Castle. His flexible, approachable style has made him one of CNN's most popular international faces.

Joining CNN from the BBC where he was a business reporter and presenter, Max has more than 30 years' broadcast experience. He currently hosts the pioneering daily global debate show *CNN Talk with Max Foster* where he explores the big news issue of the moment with a panel of guests and interaction from CNN's digital audience. He is also CNN's London and Royal Correspondent, delivering a string of high profile exclusives with the likes of The Prince of Wales, Duke of Cambridge and The Queen of Denmark.

Max also runs masterclasses in news anchoring and reporting for CNN's international affiliates and has moderated events on behalf of a diverse range of organisations including the United Nations, Google and London Business School.
