[Ana Navarro](#) is a well-known Republican strategist, political analyst, and political contributor for CNN, CNN en Español, Telemundo, ABC News, and ABC's *The View*. Dubbed a "Republican power-consultant" by the *Miami New Times*, she counts Governor Jeb Bush and Senator Marco Rubio as confidants and is respected on both sides of the aisle for her straight shooting and candor. A regular on NBC's *Meet the Press*, HBO's *Real Time with Bill Maher*, CNN's *Anderson Cooper 360*, and ABC's *The View*, she most recently served as the national Hispanic co-chair for Governor Jon Huntsman's 2012 campaign and was the national co-chair of Senator John McCain's Hispanic Advisory Council in 2008—leading the *Tampa Bay Times* to call her "a sought-after voice in Republican politics and an adviser for any presidential hopeful."

[Bakari Sellers](#) made history in 2006 when, at just 22 years old, he defeated a 26-year incumbent State Representative to become the youngest member of the South Carolina state legislature and the youngest African American elected official in the nation. In 2014, Sellers won the Democratic nomination for Lt. Governor and is widely considered to be a rising star within the Democratic Party and leading voice for his generation. Sellers served on President Barack Obama's South Carolina steering committee during the 2008 presidential election. He was named to *TIME* magazine's "40 Under 40" in 2010 as well as 2014's "The Root 100" list of the nation's most influential African Americans.
