Two decades later, as a renowned workplace development and success engineer, Anderson is dedicated to ensuring that no individual – regardless of background – will have to endure the same frustrations she did. In this interactive session, Anderson introduces the continuum of authenticity, supplemented with eight keys for building self-awareness, as well as areas each person needs to understand about themselves in order to become their best selves. She also shares five common mindset traps and techniques for overcoming them, while highlighting aspects everyone needs to own to find success in their professional and personal lives. Audience members will come away with their own unique energy formula and resilience plans, and with a better understanding of the competitive advantage, purpose, and power of their stories.
