Previously, she worked for the Republican National Committee as deputy communications director from 2013 to 2015 and held roles in election day operations and the legal department for the Mitt Romney campaign. Among various other roles in politics and law, Isgur served as a fellow at Harvard Kennedy School's Institute of Politics and a research fellow with Baylor College of Medicine's Initiative on Neuroscience and the Law.

As one of the most authoritative voices on what's going on inside the beltway, Isgur is a contributing writer for *POLITICO* and an adjunct professor at George Washington University's School of Media & Public Affairs. Whether discussing politics, leadership, or social issues, Isgur is focused on transcending partisan divides and finding common ground for the good of our nation.
